WHY HOMEOWNERSHIP MATTERS

Habitat for Humanity's plan for homeownership provides benefits to the entire county, including:

- Safer neighborhoods
- Better health outcomes
- Greater educational success for children
- Higher tax bases
- An attractive area in which to live
- More disposable income
- Builds generational wealth
- Greater pride in our communities
- Half the likelihood of relying on government assistance as adults than non-homeowner's children
- Children of homeowners are 116% more likely to graduate from college

Home ownership empowers people to reach their full potential and helps improve housing conditions in the region. The Habitat model is not only an investment in future homes in the community, but in the lives of the homeowners.

A Habitat for Humanity home is built through:

- Cash donations and grants
- Generous in-kind donations
- 200/400 hours of labor by the partner families
- Thousands of hours of volunteer time

Habitat partner families purchase their home using a zero percent interest mortgage. They pay full property taxes and insurance.
